Absolute Harvest

The Law of Absolute Harvest is a truth that can clarify our thoughts and purify our motives. Remembering that we reap exactly what we have sown helps us to keep life in perspective and impels us to plant good seed at every opportunity. Keep these things in mind:

Sow Generously not Sparingly: God gives us a supply of “seed” to be planted for His purposes. Whatever He supplies to you, sow it generously and wisely. Don’t waste your time or resources sowing seeds of unrighteousness because all you’ll get is a crop of weeds. Sow with an abundant intensity and you will reap abundantly.

Never Give Up in Doing Good: Sometimes Christians are mocked as “do-gooders.” If it happens to you, let them mock, because you will be the winner; those who do good will reap a great harvest. Keep up the good work! Tenacity in well-doing is a great quality of stewardship.

Be Patient the Spiritual Harvest Will Come: It is a well-defined, well ordered process that is in God’s hands, not our own. Just as a physical crop comes in its own time and on its own terms, the spiritual crop cannot be rushed. We till the ground, we sow the seed, we cultivate the plants, but God gives the increase for He and He alone is the Lord of the Harvest.
